This individual will be honored at **Noia's Oil & Gas Industry Achievement Awards Gala** during Oil & Gas Week and will also be featured in the conference edition of Noia News.

Nominations will be evaluated using the following criteria:

Personal Criteria:

The nominee has been involved in the Newfoundland & Labrador oil & gas industry for over 10 years and continues to demonstrate commitment to the development and growth of the local industry.

Professional Achievement:

The nominee has made a significant contribution to the Newfoundland & Labrador oil & gas industry in the areas of research, education, and technology transfer and/or business development.

Leadership and Integrity:

The nominee inspires others through outstanding leadership, leads with a high professional standard for the industry in ethics and encompasses impressive business acumen.

Innovation:

The nominee personifies innovation, has the ability to shift industry trends, and has demonstrated excellence in one or more of the following areas:

1. Innovation in the development of new technologies for harsh environments.
2. Evolution and growth of technology for local and emerging markets.
3. Commercialization of technology and/or technology transfer from research to market.

Results:

The nominee demonstrates intelligent action to create opportunity that has driven operations which are critical to evolve a company or project and has the proven ability to create change that has made a positive impact on the growth and development of the Newfoundland & Labrador oil and gas industry.

Advocacy:

As a champion of the Newfoundland and Labrador oil and gas industry, the nominee promotes markets and is a strong advocate for the industry. Also, the nominee is actively involved in the development of legislation or regulations that promote the development of the local oil and gas industry.

Volunteerism

The nominee is recognized for giving back to the community through work with not-for-profit associations, charitable organizations and community groups.
